What is Nuevo Amanecer?

Nuevo Amanecer II (A New Dawn) is a research study that is evaluating a program to improve the quality of life and stress management among Latinas with breast cancer.



What Do I Get if I Join?

- A breast cancer survivor who will be my compañera or counselor
- Meet with my compañera at a convenient location
- My compañera will offer me support and information
- I will receive information in Spanish on breast cancer, its treatments, and stress management
- I will receive up to \$100 in cash for completing the 6-month study

There is **no cost** to you for participating.

Nuevo Amanecer II is a joint effort of Circulo de Vida and the University of California, San Francisco. We will be evaluating if the program helps Latinas with breast cancer improve their quality of life and to see how their bodies react to stress. Women who enroll in the study will receive the program either now or in 6 months, depending on which group they are assigned to.
